



ANAM is an NCAT

During deployment, you *WILL* see Traumatic Brain Injuries (TBIs).

The Neurocognitive Assessment Branch (NCAB) has more than a million ANAM scores on file and available to clinicians.

Comparing pre-deployment and post-injury scores can assist with treatment and return-to-duty decisions.

Request a Computer

Simply call (210-916-9220) or send an e-mail (including your shipping address) to: ANAM.operations@amedd.army.mil

ANAM computers come from the NCAB pre-loaded with software that allows you to:

- Conduct the ANAM assessment
- Generate the ANAM report
- Encrypt the data

Currently, you must have an ANAM-specific computer to administer the Automated Neurocognitive Assessment Metrics (ANAM) following a traumatic brain injury.

What You Get From NCAB

- DA Form 3161 (digital and hard copy)
- Computer equipment
 - ANAM Laptop
 - Mouse and mouse pad
 - Locking device
 - Carrying case
- ANAM CD (briefing slides, POC list, etc.)
- PAR software (pre-installed upon request)
 - Personality Assessment Inventory Software Suite
 - Victoria Symptom Validity Test
 - Halstead Category Test

Return After Deployment

When your deployment is winding down, send an e-mail to the NCAB Logistician.

In the e-mail, tell the logistician how you want to ship the computer and other equipment (both are free) - either via Official mail (anywhere) or FedEx (CONUS).

If using FedEx, the Logistician will send you a pre-paid shipping label. Box up the computer and other equipment and mail it to the NCAB.

Check against the DA Form 3161 to ensure you have returned all equipment issued to you.

Request a Baseline

If a patient shows symptoms of TBI or concussion, ANAM can measure cognitive function, allowing you to assess function changes.

You will need to conduct a post-injury ANAM and compare it to that Soldier's pre-deployment score on file at the NCAB.

NCAB will send the baseline to you.

Arranging Repairs

If you have an ANAM computer and it needs repair, NCAB will send you a replacement.

Send a request by e-mail to the NCAB Logistician and NCAB will ship your new computer.

NCAB will also send a prepaid shipping label you can use to return the original computer. Please return it as soon as possible.

DO NOT take an ANAM computer to the local IT department. It has a special configuration.



We ship anywhere, but CONUS is much faster.

Tips

- Upon receipt, check the equipment against the provided DA Form 3161 and return the form to NCAB.

Important

- Keep the receipt — It is your insurance if the package gets lost or damaged.
